

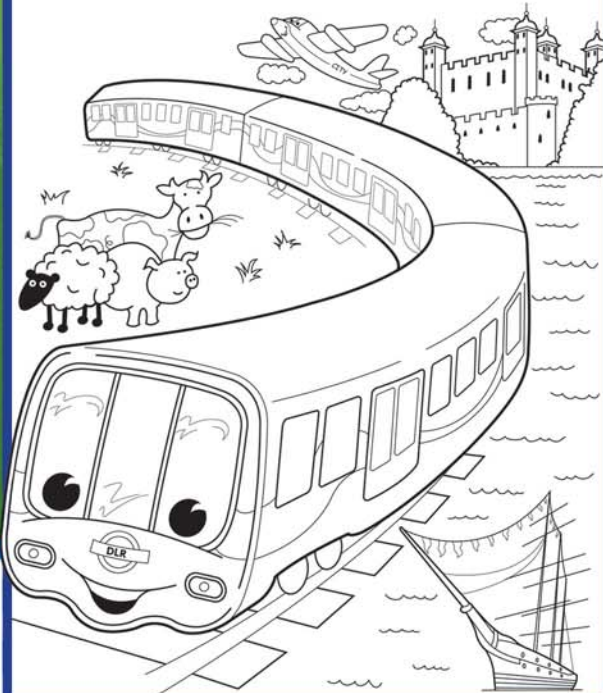

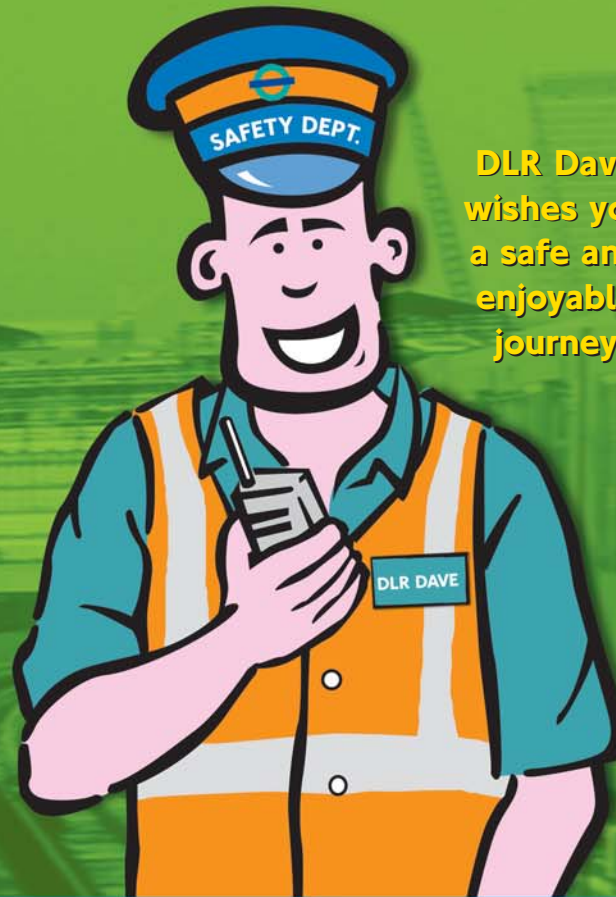

Docklands Light Railway (DLR) does all it can to make the railway as safe as possible. Please help us to keep you safe by following this advice.



And on the train

Our Staff are on board to help you, but you can help them keep you safe.



- Never try to get on or off the train as the doors are closing
- Always sit down or hold on tight
- Take care when stepping on and off the train

At the station

Platforms can seem quiet when you are waiting for a train. But DLR trains arrive quickly and quietly and because they are very heavy they cannot stop straight away.



DLR Dave says:

- Always walk on the platform – never run, ride scooters or play ball games
- Never go down the platform ramp
- If you drop something on the track, don't try to get it – ask our staff for help
- If you are travelling with adults, always stay close to them
- Keep away from the platform edge – keep behind the white line



But never on the tracks

Railway tracks are for trains, not people. Tracks and trains are electric and very, very dangerous – they can seriously injure or even kill.



- Never go near or play on railway tracks – stay away
- Never throw anything on the railway tracks or at a train – someone could get hurt
