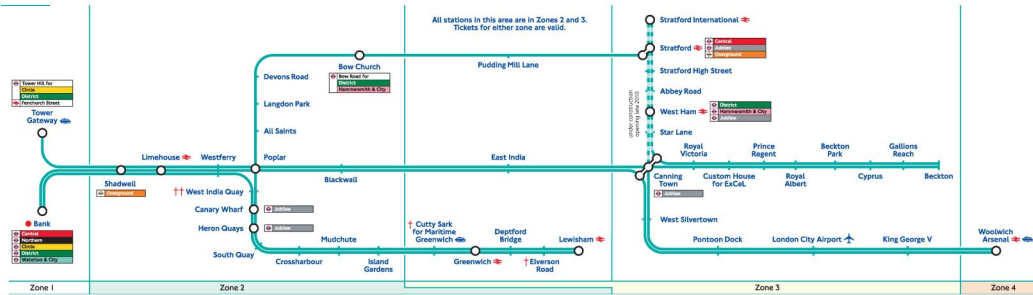

1 The Cat and Canary

📍 **Canary Wharf**
25–27 Fisherman's Walk, E14 4DH



A very popular Fuller's pub with traditional décor. Much of the furniture in the pub is from old churches,

including a pulpit and a confession box. Serves authentic pub food. *Real ales: Fuller's and guest ales*

2 The North Pole

74 Manilla Street, E14 8LG

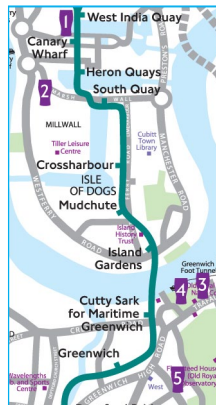
Convivial, sympathetically refurbished traditional pub serving bargain home-made food.

The Pepys Building, The Old Royal Naval College, SE10 9LW



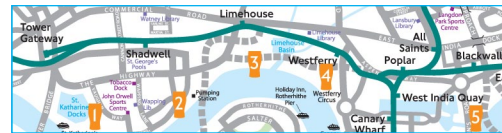
